### Overture Acting Class

**Overture: The Great Zoo!** (*grades 1-3*)  
8 Sessions for \$225

**Lions, Tigers and Flamingos, oh my!** This spring, students in grades 1-3 will sing, act, and dance their way through the greatest zoo in the entire universe! Our interdisciplinary Overture classes introduce our youngest students to theatre in a supportive, playful, and collaborative environment. Under the guidance of a head teacher, students develop voice, acting, dance, and craft skills, culminating in a sharing session for family and friends. Focusing on Western theatre and film, this class will explore the purpose of villains in storytelling through focused character creation. Most of all, through games, improvisation, and scene work, this class will help young actors develop confidence, stage presence, and the ability to respond in the moment.
